(CLEP) SUBJECTS

All law students are hereby reminded and required to complete the documentary requirements prior to their enrollment in Clinical Education Program (CLEP) subjects, as follows:

Original Student/Freshman Entry

- 1. Certificate of Good Moral Character
- 2. Transfer Credentials/Honorable Dismissal
- Official Transcript of Records (Pre-Law course)with remarks: "Copy for Arellano University School of Law"

Transferee Student

- 1. Certificates of Good Moral Character from prior Dean and a Law professor
- 2. Transfer Credentials/Honorable Dismissal
- 3. Official Transcript of Records from previous Law School with remarks:

"Copy for Arellano University School of Law"

with:*Official Transcript of Records (Pre-Law course)-Certified True Copy -Copy for the Law School prior to AUSL. If AUSL is the third law school, please see the undersigned on the required transcript.

- 4. Certificate of Eligibility for Admission into the Law Course (CEL/C-1) from the originating law school
- 5. Course Description from previous law school if subject course to be credited is not same with Arellano University School of Law curriculum (subject course/name/code)

Furthermore, students must ensure that they have taken and passed all their subjects as required in Rule 138-A, Rules of Court.

In case of non-submission of the above-mentioned school credentials and/or lack of required subjects* the concerned student may no longer be issued a certification/endorsement letter as mandated by the Supreme Court, and his/her enrolment to CLEP subject/s will be automatically forfeited.
